

RIDE COMMITTEE MEETING

___ Identify rides needed for this year (see attached).

Discuss need for planning/posting routes for un-official rides as well, e.g. Niehaus Days, JP Cycles...

___ Review this years calendar/examine current rides.

Note- An ‘official’ chapter Sunday ride the last Sunday of each month is being added this year.

___ Review format/ride template/requirements.

___ Compile a list of volunteers for each needed ride and a general idea of length and destinations.

2nd meeting – Saturday, February 27, 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.

___ Review progress of assigned rides.

___ Review/establish procedure for pre-ride discussion from ride leader and checklist/plan for Road Captain/Tail Gunner/Sheperds and Sgt. At Arms for pre-ride ‘to do’s’.

3rd meeting – Saturday, March 27, 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.

___ Review, finalize and approve all submitted rides.

___ Review pre-ride procedures.
